

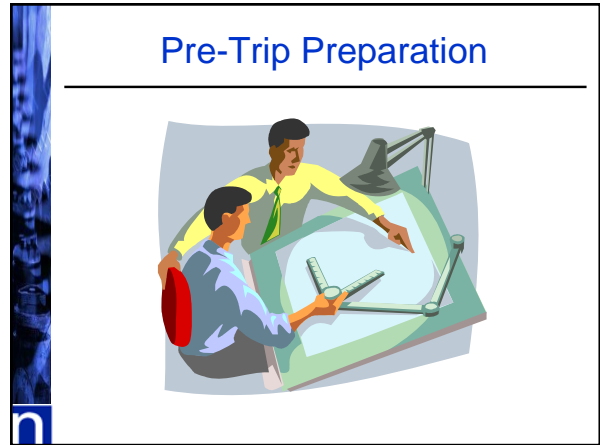

- **Acronis True Image** – Creates an exact image of your hard drive. Useful if a virus infects your computer. (www.acronis.com)
- **AJC Directory Synchronizer** – Synchronizes between your Photo directory and your USB drive. Faster than backing up the directory. (www.ajcsoft.com)

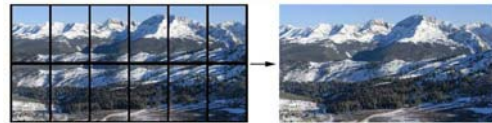
Post Processing – General Programs

- Picassa – Free, good organizer, weak editor
- Lightroom – Expensive, good organizer, strong editor, weak manipulator.
- Photoshop – Elements – Inexpensive, average organizer, strong editor, strong manipulator.
- Photoshop – Expensive, average organizer, strong general graphic editor, strong manipulator.

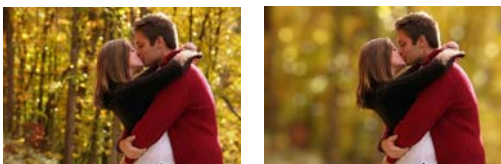

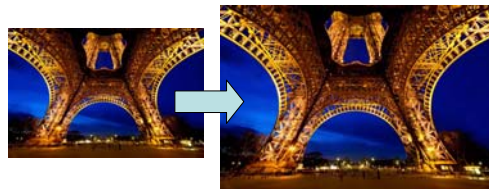
